What you will do

As an Investment Manager on environmental impact vehicles, you will:

2. Participate in the sourcing and the analysis of a pipeline of environmental projects in Europe (private equity investments in start-ups/scale-ups, mostly Series A-B);

4. Prepare and present investment recommendations to our clients;
5. Monitor the portfolio with the adequate level of involvement (e.g.: board seat, site visits);

7. Measure & monitor the impact generated by the funded projects;
8. Play a key role in ensuring the values and culture of Telos Impact on a daily basis.
